

Coastal culture and micro farm distillery



Oslofjord museum

Located right on the western shores of the Oslofjord, with its incredible beautiful view over the fjord, you can experience the coastal culture at the Oslofjord Museum. Focuses on the heritage of the Oslofjord. Here you can try a rowing simulator for virtual water trips, a part of the museum's innovative program for learning and experience. The museum also has a collection of old small(er) wooden boats and is situated where the polar ship "Maud" was built for the famous Norwegian arctic explorer Roald Amundsen. Maud is now in progress of returning home to Vollen.

The distillery tour

Eplegaarden, meaning "The Apple Farm" is a family run farm with a 5 hectare apple orchard, situated on the Hurum peninsula, 90 meters above sea level. The farm has been in the family for five generations, and fruit has always been the major income source.

In 2011 they built a farm distillery and produce our own apple brandy. Learn how to make apple brandy - legal! Be sure to check the oak barrels, say your opinion and help create the story of Norwegian apple brandy.

The Coastal Culture centre

Kystkultursenteret (the coastal culture centre) is beautifully located in the middle of Son. The centre consists of a museum dock with

old boats, exhibitions, a museum shop, a goldsmith and more. Jostushuset tells the story of a fisherman's home in Son. The smithy has changing exhibitions about life in Son in the old days.
