

Idyllic archipelago and fine art at Henie-Onstad Art Centre



15 minutes by buss from Oslo you will find Sandvika. Located right on the bay, with its incredible beautiful archipelago, with large and small islands. The boats MS Rigmor and MS Rigfar is visited by 35 000 travellers each year and MS Rigmor is one of Norways oldest route-driven wooden ferry. The two boats that will bring you to the islands and give you an unforgettable tour of the archipelago.

You have the possibility to disembark on one of the islands for a little swim or just a walk around enjoying the scenery before returning to Sandvika and a visit to Henie-Onstad Art Centre.

Hennie-Onstad Art Centre is known as a leading institution in international contemporary art from the 1900s. They have a unique expertise in the interdisciplinary artistic field, emphasizing the relationship between art, music, performance and avant gard. Located in scenic surrounding, HOK includes 3 500 m2 of exhibiton space, HOK lab for children, a museum shop and a sculpture park that have close ties to HOK's exhibition history and are responsive to this scenic setting.

If the weather is nice we recommend you to enjoy a lunch or dinner outside in the spectaculare surrounding at the gallery.
