

Visit the idyllic village in Vollen and the Oslofjord museum



30 minutes by boat from Oslo, operating from June 1st until end of August - departures every Saturday and Sunday, you will find the idyllic village Vollen. Located right on the western shores of the Oslofjord, with its incredible beautiful view over the fjord.

Vollen's trade history began in 1870, when Hans Kr. Christensen established enterprises such as Volden Hotel, a market and a bakery, as well as the Volden post office which opened in 1895.

Today Vollen is a coastal pearl, a small village where one can experience nice walks along the shore, shop and dine in quiet surroundings. Or you can book a guided historical tour for groups.

Rent an electric bike and explore what Vollen and the coastal area can offer. Great beaches are also to be found in the area.

The Oslofjord Museum at Vollen in Asker focuses on the coastal heritage of the Oslofjord. A rowing simulator for virtual water trips is part of the museum's innovative program for learning and experience.

The museum also has a collection of old small(er) wooden boats and is situated where

the polar ship "Maud" was built for the famous Norwegian arctic explorer Roald Amundsen. The work of returning Maud to Vollen is now in progress.
