

The idyllic Bærums Verk offers 50 shops, craftsmen, workshops, galleries and dining places, all in the authentic surroundings from the early 1600s.

The old "Verksgata" consists of old workers houses from 1700s. Her you can find among other blacksmiths, glass blowers, wooden craftsman and silvesmith.

A stroll down "Verksgata" is a pleasant experience in itself. From the smithy's sounds the clang of the anvil, and from the carpenter's workshop one can enjoy the smell of freshly cut wood. If one is lucky, one can also see the most exquisite glasses being blown. "Custom made" gifts are being produced by the artisans at Bærums Verk.

Every year in June, they open the sculpture park. The Sculpture park is the country's largest representative of Norwegian, three-dimensional art, thanks to a collaboration with the Norwegian sculptor Association.

After an adventurous tour surrounding the historic environment,

enjoy a meal at "Værtshuset Bærums Verk" the oldest eatery in Norway or "The pancake house".
