

Outdoor activities at Bergvang farm



Bergvang is located in scenic surroundings with direct access to water, forests and fields. It takes about 30 minutes' drive from Oslo to Sandvika and further to Asker.

On our way to the farm, we will pass by Skaugum, the official residence of crown prince Haakon of Norway and his wife crown princess Mette-Marit.

Bergvang originated in 1930 and was developed for nursery, horticulture and gardening. Strawberries and fruit trees were the main income and the owner travelled to Oslo with fruits and berries which were sold in the markets in the city.

In the early 60's the farm invested in 2000 m2 greenhouse and was one of the biggest garden center in the area up to start of 1990.

Bergvang offers different outdoors activities, from horse rides to dog sledding sleigh, from fishing to animals care.

You can find many exotic and exiting animals: llamas, alpacas, highland cattle, Norwegian sheep's, donkeys and a peacock. In addition to Icelandic horses, Shetland ponies, Dole horse, island dogs, huskies, cats, chickens, geese, rabbits and a beehive.

You can visit the animals and get to know more of the Alpacas. If you wish, you can take a short walk along with the alpacas in the premises.

You can also spend time at the Dog yard to learn about how the huskies are trained and tell you

about the Finnmarksløpet Race - a true test of stamina and Europe's longest dog race covering 1,000 kilometers. The dogs love attention and you will have time to say hello.

If you wish, you can sit in a dog sledge ride on wheel of about 7 minutes in the surroundings. During your visit, you can enjoy refreshments with homemade pastry (svele) served either in the farm shop, or in the lavvo.
