

Historic Oscarsborg Fortress and Drøbak



Historic exploration in a new way – an exciting day for friends and families

Only 40 minutes by public bus from downtown Oslo you will find the idyllic town of Drøbak with the famous Christmas house, the beautiful wooden houses and Father Christmas' cousin.

Just outside Drøbak, where the Oslo fjord is at its narrowest, you find Oscarsborg Fortress with five museums. There are also restaurants, galleries and on the spot activities for children.

All year around you may order a guided Tour at Oscarsborg. From June 25th until August 19th you may attend the Open Tour at 13.30, tickets are available in the kiosk at Oscarsborg..

Tour Description:

Ferry from Drøbak to Oscarsborg, app. 5 minutes, there you may have a guided Tour for 1,5 hours. This tour gives an insight in the history of Oscarsborg fortress, the events leading up to the second world war, the sinking of the "Blücher", the underwater embankment, the main fortress and all the other fortifications.

A nice lunch either at the Oscarsborg Hotel & Resort or at Kumlegården in the city of Drøbak.

The "Christmas Town" of Drøbak. With its picturesque wooden houses, galleries, small shops and cozy cafes Drøbak is worth a visit. In Drøbak you can visit Tregaardens Christmas House and Father Christmas' cousin at the local Tourist Information or include a visit to Drøbak Aquarium.
