Eidsvoll 1814 is a house full of exciting history. For Norwegian's it is one of the most important national symbols, inextricably tied to the constitution, independence and the dramatic events of 1814.

In April 1814, against the backdrop of the Napoleonic wars in Europe, 112 representatives met at Eidsvoll with a formidable task: to decide the nation's future.

Six weeks later they signed the Constitution and elected a king for the new independent state of Norway; a crucial event remembered ever after in our 17th of May celebrations.

Wergelands Hus (Visitor's Center) - the center is located only 50 m from the historic building with nice outdoor surroundings. The center focus on engaging for democracy and offers a video experience out of the ordinary, in a spectacular cinema. It has captivated all visitors with its magnificent images and strong message.
