If you follow the beautifully forested Finnskogen Trail northwards from Gravberget Gård for just short of an hour, you come to a sign indicating the way to 'Ingeborgsteinen'.

Walk the couple of hundred metres down to the stone and reflect upon the tragic story that once took place here.

Ingeborg Henriksdatter Liitiäinen was born in Gravberget in 1720 and, like many others at that time, had a tough start in life. She was put into service as a young girl and had her first child at the age of seventeen. She had another child the following year, the father of which was said to be a married man from Gravberget. The women of the

woman from the village.

Ingeborg lived through the winter of 1741-1742 beneath this stone, a few kilometres north of the settlement, and the story tells how, following a paternity case in the spring of 1742, she was chased away from here too. She apparently set up home beneath another stone, this time closer to Haldammen.

There are many tragic stories about Ingeborg and no one today knows how she died and where she is buried. She ended up with five children with different fathers, and spent her whole life in Finnskogen.

The myth lives on...
