10.30 Departure for visit to Glomdal Museum with guided tour in the herb garden and to the 'Apothecary' exhibition. An outstanding exhibition concerning the use of herbs and liquor in medicine from a Nordic perspective.

12.00 Onwards towards Atlungstad Brenneri with a 'Munch' on the way. We stop for a guided tour around the Munch Centre at Løten, Edvard Munch's place of birth, no visit of which is complete without a taste of the famous Munch
