This lovely two hundred year old mansion nestles on a peninsula on the beautiful lake shore of Laxsjön, part of the Dalslands Canal. The manor is only 2 hours from Gothenburg or 2.5 hours from Oslo. A must do when in Dalsland is to explore the canal from either land or boat. At Baldersnäs itself, as well as the majestic surroundings, there are lots of activities and events to do all year round: the Wine Cellar where we hold tastings; the Spa and Relaxation area with jacuzzi and hot tub, and the sauna with a view of the lake. When you visit Baldersnäs, one of Dalsland's top attractions, you'll no doubt work up an appetite. The best place to satisfy that is our restaurant serving lunches and five and seven course dinners, with the emphasis firmly on using locally grown, fresh, seasonal produce. If you fancy something sweet as well then our terrace cafe serves homemade cakes, buns and biscuits as well as locally produced ice cream. Baldersnäs Park is open seven days a week, and is often described as the 'Romantic Park'. After a day's activities you can enjoy an evening stroll on the peninsula and through the park, where the views of the lake are breathtaking. You can choose to stay in the manor house or in the new wing overlooking the lake. Whatever you decide, we guarantee your overnight experience will be truly unique.
