

Paddling on Kynna

The price includes:

Hire of a canoe with two oars and two life jackets. Picking up and returning the canoe and equipment at Kynnbrua bridge.

Daily hire: **NOK 350**

24-hour hire: **NOK 450**

Hire of a canoe with two oars and two life jacket, incl. transport back to the starting point. Canoe, oars and equipment pick up and return by agreement.

Daily hire: **NOK 1200**

24-hour hire: **NOK 1300**

Kynna is a watercourse in Finnskogen ideal for canoeing and kayaking. It is a quiet, calm, tiny river that suits both new beginners and those who are a little more experienced.

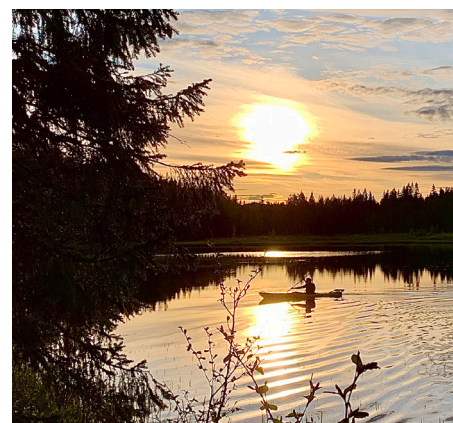
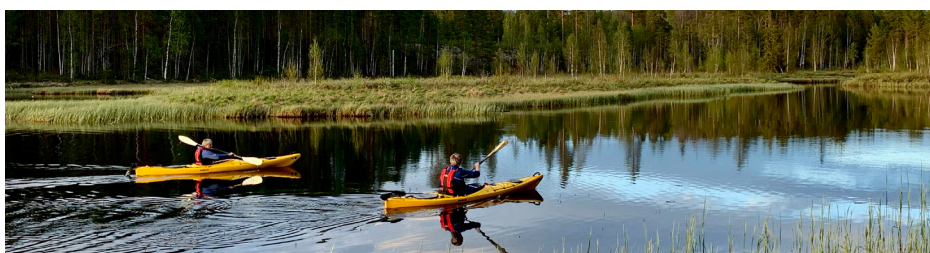
There is a stretch of approximately 26 kilometres that is suitable for paddling. The river takes you through three municipalities and a practically untouched landscape. There are several lovely rest stops along the way where it is easy to disembark and with camping ground.

The small river meanders beautifully down, bringing you close to nature. All along the river, there is plenty of wildlife to see. During the trip you can test your knowledge of bird song, try your

luck at fishing, and look at what the beavers have been building. The river also passes through five small elongated lakes during the stretch of river you can paddle along.

The tour starts at Kynnbrua bridge.

Here the main road crosses river Kynna into Graverget. This is the hub of the area – the approximate centre of the watercourse. You can park here and there are toilets, a jetty and water post. This is also where you agree on a time to pick up your canoe, oars and life jacket. You can paddle in two directions from here.



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
