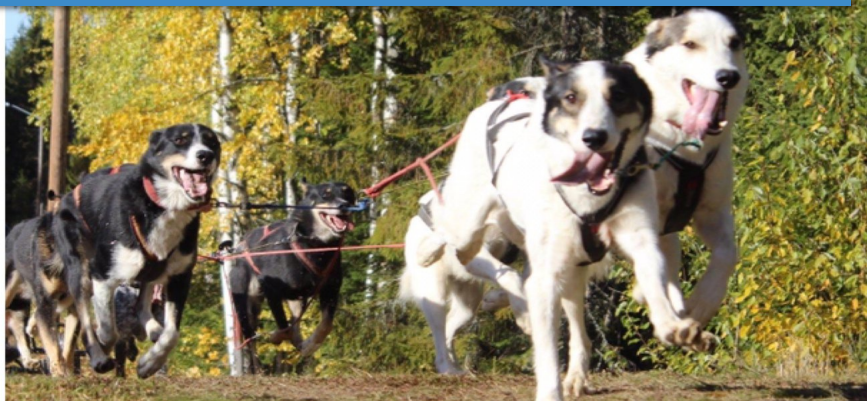




Outdoor activities at Bergvang farm



Few experiences are more soothing than to be in beautiful surroundings with animals. Bergvang operates a sustainable farm open to the public and organizes activities such as horseback riding, dog sledging, feeding of the animals. Welcome to an unforgettable day at the countryside.

Situated in Asker only 30 minutes' drive from Oslo. We will pass by Skaugum, the official residence of crown prince Haakon of Norway and his wife crown princess Mette-Marit.

Bergvang was established in 1930 and for more than 30 years it was one of the largest garden centers in the area until early 90's.

Explore the beautiful nature through different outdoors activities such as horse riding, dog sledging, fishing in the lake and feeding the animals. Meet exotic animals such as: lamas, alpacas, highland cattle, Norwegian sheep's, donkeys, a peacock, Icelandic horses, Shetland ponies, Dole horse, huskies, cats, chickens, geese, rabbits and the bee hive.

Alpaca walking is a unique experience where you get to meet, handle and have the responsibility for your own alpaca, while walking in a scenic Norwegian landscape. Meet the huskies that are trained for the world longest doc race (1000 km) the Finnmark Race. The dogs love attention and to meet you.

Enjoy a light meal and refreshments either in the farm café or around the fire in the lavvo with homemade pastry (svele).
