The Oslofjord Museum - Coastal Heritage

Beautifully located on a penninsula by the you find the Oslofjord Museum in the charming village Vollen. Try your rowing skills in the simulator, a part of the museum's innovative program for learning and experience. The polar ship "Maud" was built in Vollen for the famous Norwegian arctic explorer Roald Amundsen. Admire the collection of old small(er) wooden boats and the handicraft that went into making them.

Distillery tour

Eplegaarden, meaning "The Apple Farm" is a family run farm situated 90 meters above sea level with spectacular view of Oscarsborg and the Oslo Fjord.

Guided tour of the farm distillery. Learn how to make apple brandy - legal! Check the oak barrels and take part in creating the story of Norwegian apple brandy. You may by fresh pure apple juice with your personal label for presents or souvenirs.

The Coastal Culture centre

Kystkultursenteret (the coastal culture centre) is beautifully located in the middle of the summer village Son. A museum dock with old boats, changing exhibitions about life in the old times, a museum shop, a goldsmith and more.

Jostushuset tells the story of a fisherman's home in Son.
