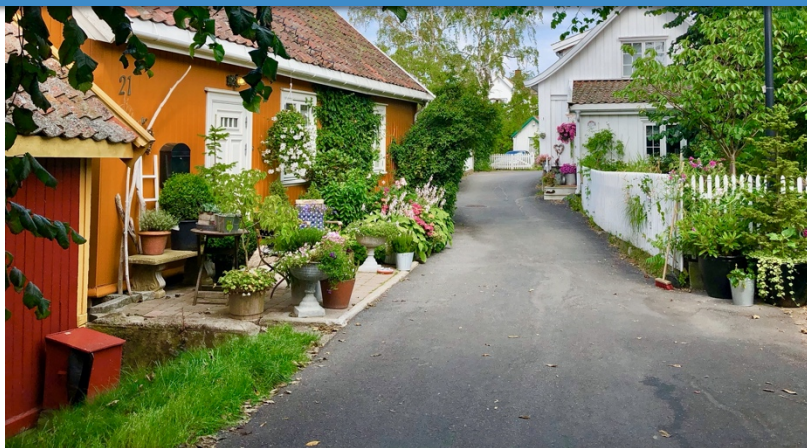


Drøbak – By the sunny shores of the Oslo fjord

Less than 30 km from downtown Oslo you will find Drøbak with Tregaardens Christmas House and Father Christmas' Post Office with its own special post stamp.

Enjoy a day in Drøbak, book a lunch at one of the local eateries, for example Kumlegaarden, Sjøstjernen or Galleri Café Teskje.

While in Drøbak you should include a visit to Drøbak Aquarium, Oscarsborg Fortress and museum for newspaper cartoonists.

When leaving Drøbak you stop at Galleri Finsrud where you will find the world's only working Perpetuum mobile.

The multi artist will give us an introduction to art and techniques he uses and maybe a tour of "The World's largest model railroad on 12 square meters".
