

Heard of the Twist? Only 15 minutes outside of Oslo you find one of the two installations by Kusama in Norway, and the most northern underwater sculpture park by Jason Tyler. Discover the area of Sandvika and Høvikodden with beautiful archipelago and sandy beaches.

Henie Onstad Art Centre hosts temporary exhibitions as well as the Henie Onstad collection, which includes works by Picasso, Matisse, Beuys, Christo, Monet and famous Norwegian artists such as Weidemann. The museum hosts the HOK lab for children, a museum shop and an outdoor sculpture park. Stroll by the sea along the coastal path and enjoy a meal at the terrace.

Across the bay 15 minutes by foot Sjøholmen Art Cafe and Gallery is located. Discover the famous underwater sculpture park that encourages marine life by Jason Tyler.

The best part of the Oslo Fjord Archipelago is accessible from Sandvika. Enjoy a cruise with MS Rigmor or MS Rigfar, one of Norways oldest routedriven wooden ferries, see the islands and enjoy an unforgettable tour of the archipelago. Possiblities to make stops on an island, camping is

popular on some islands, or just have a swim in a soothing and relaxing environment. Sandvika town has a nice promenade along the river to the beach front Kadettangen and the Kalvøya island with plains and beaches.

Claude Monet lived in Sandvika one winter and his favourite motive was the iron bridge and the Kolsås mountain which is on display at the Henie Onstad Art Centre.
