

Art Tour- Full day activities

Tour suggestion – Art tour of Fornebu and Bærums Verk. Visit to Norway’s first Ironwork.



Discover world class art and architecture and sights that are free of charge. We visit the peninsula of Fornebu and continue to the historic and picturesque site Bærums Verk with its artisan galleries and historic wooden houses.

We will guide you through some of the impressive art and architecture of Fornebu, including the digital art at the Equinor building. We will walk along the coastal path, enjoy the scenic view, more art and get a guided introduction to the “Imprints” sculpture park made by artist Magne Furuholmen (A-ha). A stroll thru the old airport which is turned into a cultural site with different museums and galleries.

We continue to Sandvika past the bridge “Løkke Bro” which was built in Bærums Verk and painted by Claude Monet when he resided in Bærum. Bærums Verk is located by the river Lomma, now a charming site with shops, eateries, a sculpture park and several galleries. A stop by the gallery of the creator of the “iron roses” - the sculptor in memory of the lost lives of the attack on July 22nd. In the glass hut we will have a demonstration of glass blowing. Lunch on site.

First stop at Asker Museum. A tour of its beautiful sculpture garden and the well preserved wooden artist homes. Here we get the history of the artist colony that formed the Norwegian language and do not be surprised if you are engaged in some folk dance.

We will drive past the crown prince and princess resident on our way to Bergvang. At Bergvang we will meet the alpacas, the huskies that love dog sledding, the horses and all the other species at Bergvang visitor farm. Enjoy in activities such as dog sledding and meet the alpacas.
