ARE YOU A CONSCIOUS TRAVELLER WHO WANTS TO CONTRIBUTE LOCALLY?

Try out a four-day trip with an electric car, close-to-nature experiences and local food. Here you get the opportunity to contribute locally with beach cleaning and picking Pacific oysters, which are an unwanted and invasive species in our waters.

DAY 1

- Rent an **electric driven car**.
- **Oyster harvesting** in Jeløya. Experience **canoeing** on lake Vansjø.
- Take a therapeutic **walk with alpacas**.
- **Farm stay** at Østre Kjærnes in an apartment. You can prepare your own food based on local produce.

DAY 2

- Visit the only **local dairy** where they make cheese.
- **Guided city walk** in Gamlebyen (the Old Town), Fredrikstad.
- **Beach cleaning** in the Hvaler archipelago with a guide.
- **Overnight stay** at Homlungen Lighthouse. The islet is part of Ytre Hvaler National Park.

DAY 3

- Taste **local food and produce**.
- Walk along the **coastal path** by Bunnefjorden.
- Guided visit to the **house of polar explorer Roald Amundsen**.
- Stay at **Breivoll Gård**, a year-round facility run by the Norwegian Trekking Association (DNT).

DAY 4

- Morning **kayaking** on Bunnefjorden with a guide when needed.
- Return to Oslo by electric car.
