## **Tour description**

### **Drøbak.**

A local guide take you on a walk through Drøbak's history and soul. Guided tours of 60 minutes.

### **Coastal Path from Drøbak to Ramme**

Explore the forest and the Oslo fjord with an experienced guide. Total distance about 5 km (3 miles), moderately challenging terrain. During the trip you will be served a homemade Norwegian style bun and coffee.

### **Ramme – A hidden gem**

Arriving at Ramme a unique world reveals it selves. A destination on its own; with a boutique hotel, restaurant, museum, gallery, one of Norway's most extraordinary gardens and Edvard Munch's summer house.

### **Hvitsten**

In the 19th Fred Olsen Line was established in Hvitsten and is why the shipping company has exhibited 37 figureheads made by famous Norwegian artists, used on their ships in the period 1938 - 1976. Maps and description can be found at the old school or a local guide can be provided on request.
