Enjoy a day outdoor hiking along the shores of Bunnefjorden from Roal Amundsens home to the Norwegian hiking associations service point at Breivoll.

Tour description Uranienborg

From 1908 and for 20 years, Roald Amundsen lived in his house Uranienborg at Svartskog. In 1911 Amundsen and his men skied to the South Pole as the first to reach the pole point. In 1928 he disappeared in the arctic and Uranienborg was left full of stories from the life he had lived and the people around him, including the secrets he had tried to keep to himself.

Hear the history and explore the secrets with a knowledgeable guide and polar explorer.

Costal path

Walk the coastal path from Svartskog to Breivoll. It will take you on small country roads, forrest paths and over hilly heights. The hike is about 10 km.

Breivoll Farm

Breivoll Farm is a year-round service point for the Norwegian Hiking association (DNT). The offer accommodation with good food and a cozy atmosphere in old timber houses. It is possible to rent a kayak if you have a registered "Wet card". Breivoll Gård DNT is a small oasis in the heart of the Bunnefjord, only a short distance from the capital.
